A "green field" for Africa's community & youth development

- Grassroots baseball is rapidly growing across Africa. 22+ countries in Africa have some form of baseball activity (baseball, softball, or Baseball5).
- Only 9 countries have baseball or softball fields* (many in poor condition)
- Significant need for community leadership and baseball infrastructure to enable organized play across the continent.

The World Baseball and Softball
Confederation - Africa (WBSC Africa) has 23
member countries in Africa with multiple
national teams represented in the top 70 of
baseball and softball.

Rapid adoption of Baseball5 is happening across Africa, with Kenya ranking in the top 10 globally.
